

During the seminar, students showed a high level of engagement by actively






The Department of Commerce and the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) in association with Krishna Foundation, organized a workshop on "Introduction to Securities Markets and Financial Wellness" on August 20, 2024, at 11:30 a.m in the college auditorium. The session aimed to provide students with foundational knowledge on securities markets, financial wellness. The resource person for the event was Mr. Naveen Punjabi, an Associate Professor and Director of the Placement Cell at HR College. He was introduced by Dr. Kashyap Ganatra. A total of 84 students attended the workshop, which proved to be highly informative and engaging. During the session, speaker enlightened the students about the various types of bank accounts, including single accounts, joint accounts, either-or-survivor accounts, and anyone-or-survivor accounts. He also discussed the different modes of purchasing shares, highlighting the direct method through the capital market and investing via mutual funds. The workshop delved into the differences between the primary market and the secondary market, explaining the types of public issues and the importance of each. Speaker emphasized the necessity of regulation in the market and elaborated on the role of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI). He discussed SEBI's key mandates, the work it has done in the financial sector, and how it protects investors' rights. In addition to explaining the basic rules of investing, speaker introduced the students to the Sarthi App, a platform initiated by SEBI to assist investors. The topic of derivatives and the risks associated with them was also addressed, providing students with an understanding of complex financial instruments. The session further covered topics such as investing in sovereign gold bonds and electronic gold, fixed deposits (FDs), and the tax implications associated with them. The students were also made aware of various regulatory bodies governing the financial markets. The workshop concluded with the Principal, IQAC Coordinator, and resource person being invited on stage, where the Principal presented speaker with a sapling as a token of appreciation. 

The session outlined the 10 essential steps to writing a research paper, beginning with understanding the assignment and choosing a research topic. Preliminary research, developing research questions, and collecting supporting evidence followed. Dr. Ceena Paul stressed the importance of creating a research outline using the IMRD (Introduction, Methods, Results, Discussion) formula. The next steps involved writing a first draft, revising it, citing sources, and completing a final revision. The session concluded with a question-and-answer segment where students raised insightful questions. Dr. Sunita Mishra and Dr. Nooruzia Qazi presented a token of appreciation to Dr. Paul. - 3. Yawa (Peru): Explained how turbines in areas with high temperatures can generate water in regions facing water scarcity.
- 4. My H2O (Rural China): Illustrated how polluted water can be effectively cleaned for use.
- 5. Blohm (London): Presented how lamps can be created using orange peels and coffee outer skin.
- 6. Texfed (Uganda, Africa): Described how banana stems are used to create strings and other products.
- 7. Thaley (India): Showed how a student innovatively used plastic to create a pair of shoes.
- 8. Recharkha (India): Demonstrated how plastic waste is transformed into eco-friendly bags.


