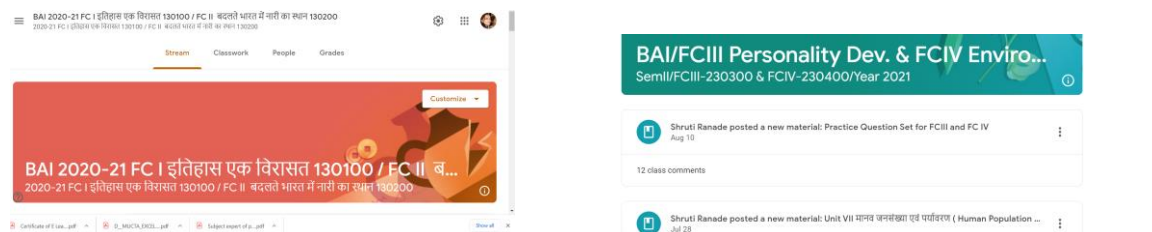

Indian Cultural Heritage & Unity in Diversity

Assignment Brief:

The students were given an assignment to instill a sense of **pride in Indian cultural heritage** and understand the concept of **unity in diversity**.

Task:

Students were asked to create and present a **PowerPoint Presentation (PPT)** on **Indian Cultural Heritage** through the following themes:

1. **Languages** – The diversity of languages spoken across India and their historical significance.
2. **Maps** – Representation of cultural and historical sites across different states.
3. **Art and Craft** – Traditional art forms, handicrafts, and their cultural importance.
4. **Science and Technology** – Contributions of ancient and modern India in the field of science and technology.

The objective was to **enhance awareness** about India's rich heritage and promote **appreciation for its diverse cultural aspects**.

 - Women's rights under the Indian Penal Code (IPC)

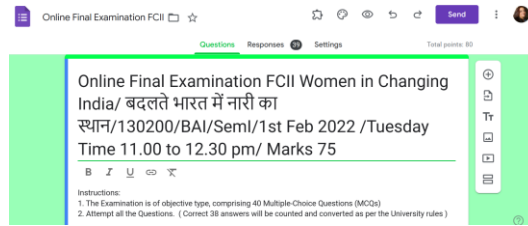
This assignment encouraged students to gain **practical knowledge** about women's legal rights, fostering **awareness and empowerment**.

Year 2021-22

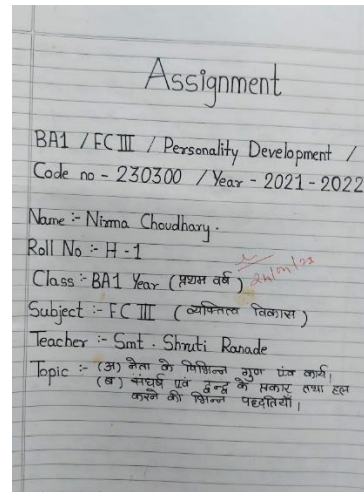

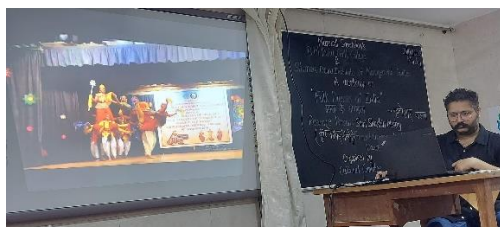
