Ruia Girls' College, NAAC Accredited B+ Grade (3rd Cycle), Awarded 'Maharshi Karve Best College 2022-23' affiliated to S.N.D.T Women's University, Mumbai, in association with Internal Quality Assurance Cell, organised a Webinar on “Impact of Population Explosion on Environment” on 8th July, 2024 at 10.45 a.m. The Eminent Resource Person was Mr. Nikhil Mene, Sub-Engineer, Water Supply Project Management Department, Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai (MCGM). He conveyed that Population explosion refers to the drastic increase in the number of individuals living in a particular area, which results in strained resources and challenges for the environment. The impact of the population explosion on the environment is significant and wide-ranging, affecting various aspects of the ecosystem. One of the most pressing issues caused by the population explosion is the increased demand for natural resources such as water, food, and energy. As the population grows, resources become more scarce, leading to overexploitation of natural resources and the degradation of ecosystems. This can result in deforestation, loss of biodiversity, depletion of water sources, and pollution of air, water, and soil. Additionally, the increased demand for housing, infrastructure, and urbanisation to accommodate the growing population leads to habitat destruction and fragmentation, threatening the survival of many plant and animal species. Furthermore, the sheer number of people on the planet contributes to increased waste production and pollution. Landfills overflow with garbage, plastic waste




- **An Educational Visit to “Veermata Jijabai Bhosale Botanical Udyan and Zoo, Mumbai” on August 23, 2024**


- Group discussion on “Caste based reservation promotes social justice or creates new inequalities” on 11th March 2025
