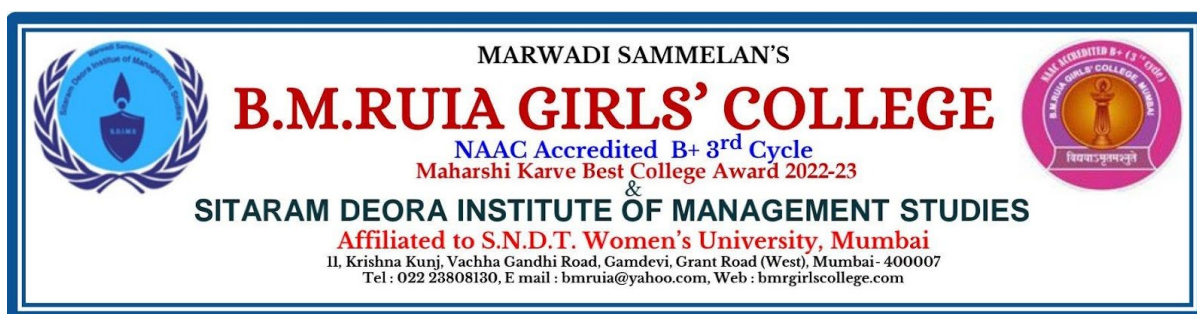
insights about developments happening in PAN India. Also, important concepts pertaining to Digital Literacy and utilities in MS Office were also covered in the training.
