This MOU is entered into on the 24 day of January, 2019 by and between Post Graduate Department of Commerce of Maniben Nanavati Women's College, Vile Parle (West), Mumbai- 400056, affiliated to S.N.D.T. Women's University and Post Graduate Department of Commerce of B.M. Ruia Girls' College, 11 Krishna Kunj, Vaccha Gandhi Road, Gamdevi, Grant Road (West), Mumbai-400 007, affiliated S.N.D.T. Women's University for conducting a 'Faculty Exchange and Students Development Programme'.

The aforesaid Colleges are hereafter known individually 'Institute' & collectively 'Institutions'.

1. Objective of MOU:

The objectives of the MOU are:

- To provide and enhance expression and sharing of knowledge amongst peer students from two different Institutions.
- To provide exposure to the students about learning aid & infrastructure of Institutions offering same Post Graduate Programme & Specialization.
- To inculcate in students competitive skills for enhancing their academic interest.
- To promote research/continuing education activities between both the Institutions.



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2. About the Faculty Exchange and Students Development Programme:

The MOU is between the Department of Commerce of M.N.W. College, Vile Parle (West) and B. M. Ruia Girls' College, 11 Krishna Kunj, Vaccha Gandhi Road, Gamdevi, Grant Road West.

- Ten students of M.Com will be identified by both the respective Institutions for the purpose of exchange. These students will get exposure of activities conducted in the both Institutes.
- The above students will be participating in all the activities undertaken within the purview of the programme and will be entitled for participating certificates. The activities so undertaken will help the students in developing their competency and personality.
- The activities to be conducted during the programme shall be decided by mutual consent of Head of Departments of Commerce of both the Institutions.
- The Head of Departments reserve right for any change of activity by their mutual consent with each other before the conduction of programme.

3. Proposed Modes of Collaboration:

The Post Graduate Department of Commerce of Maniben Nanavati Women's College, Vile Parle (West), Mumbai-56 and B. M. Ruia Girls' College, 11 Krishna Kunj Vaccha Gandhi Road, Gamdevi, Grant Road West, proposes to collaborate through the following:

- Propagation of education and training in the areas of mutual interest.
- Co-operation and conduction of various activities with consent of faculty members
- A schedule of activities and conduction will be drafted with the agreement and consent of Head of Departments of both the Institutions along with this MOU.

4. Duration of the Programme & MOU:

The Students Exchange Programme shall be conducted between the two Institutions involving exchange of students, for three working Days. The undersigned MOU will be valid for two academic years i.e., 2018-2019 & 2019-2020.

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5. Terms & Conditions:

- The cost of infrastructural utility including use of classrooms, teaching aids, books, resources, internet, laptops, OHP, Projectors, etc. shall be borne by both the Institutions individually.
- The expenses relating to the Visits, Certificates, Prizes, Trophy's, Refreshments, Honorarium expenses for inviting Experts, Judges during the programme shall be borne by both the Institutions individually.
- The Institutions are free to arrange sponsors for part or whole of the programme.

The responsibility for conduction of this programme shall be of the Head of Departments of Commerce of each of the Institutions. They can depute their faculty members for the exchange programme.

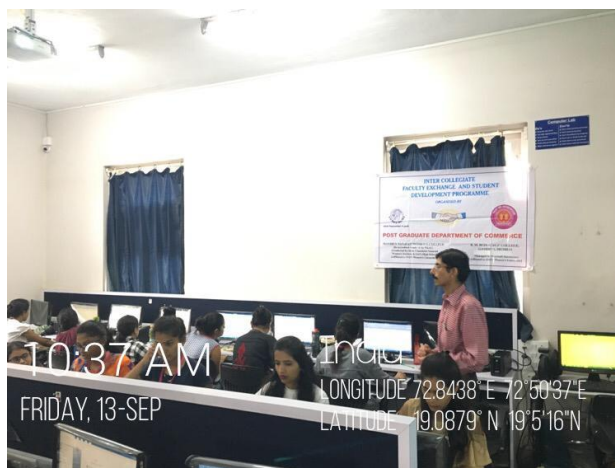
1. SPSS TRAINING PROGRAM

Date: 13th, 14th & 28th September 2019

Event: 3 Days SPSS Training Program

Speaker: Dr. Sandip Bhanot, Associate Professor from SIES College of Management Studies, Nerul, Navi Mumbai

Participants: 15 M. Com students from B.M Ruia Girls' College and Maniben Nanavati Women's College.



Session I – 13th September, 2019

- In the first session conducted on 13th September 2019 (Friday) from 10 am to 12 pm, the trainer explained to the students the basic statistical tools like measures of central tendency and how they can be found for any variable using Excel.
- The trainer explained in detail about meaning of variable and the concept of dependent and independent variables. The trainer engaged in a question answer session where he asked students about their topics of dissertations and explained to them what they can take as dependent and independent variables in their dissertation.
- Tools like correlation and regression were explained and how they can be applied to quantitative variables.

- Trainer explained students the meaning of hypothesis and the concept of null and alternate hypothesis.
- A visual simulation was shown to the students by the trainer about how hypothesis can be taken for qualitative variables and how chi-square test can be used.

Session II - 14th September, 2019

- In the second session conducted on 14th September 2019 (Saturday) from 10 am to 12 pm, the trainer explained how the software SPSS can be installed in the computer. Then it was explained how variables can be defined on SPSS by going to variable view and then how data can be entered one by one in the data view. The types of scales i.e. nominal, ordinal, interval and ratio were also explained so that variables can be categorized under these types.

Session III – 28th September, 2019

- In the third session conducted on 28th September 2019 (Saturday) from 10 am to 12 pm, the trainer taught how different descriptive statistics can be found on SPSS for the variables.
- The use of tools like correlation, regression and chi-square test was taken. Also, the interpretation of the tables was explained so that hypothesis can be tested. Also use of t-test and ANOVA was taken on SPSS.


All the Sessions were very useful as it will help the students to analyze the data collected in their dissertations. The use of SPSS will first enable the students to enter the data collected from their questionnaires into the software. Then they can make appropriate hypothesis and use different tests of significance to test these hypotheses.
