Reports with Snaps: A National Level Quiz on 'Hindi Sahitya aur Paryavaran' was organized on June 5, 2024, under the aegis of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) to celebrate World Environment Day. The event aimed to raise awareness about environmental issues through Hindi literature, highlighting the works of poets and authors who address nature and the environment.

The quiz, held online, saw over 200 participants from various institutions across India. Questions focused on Hindi literary works that explore environmental themes. 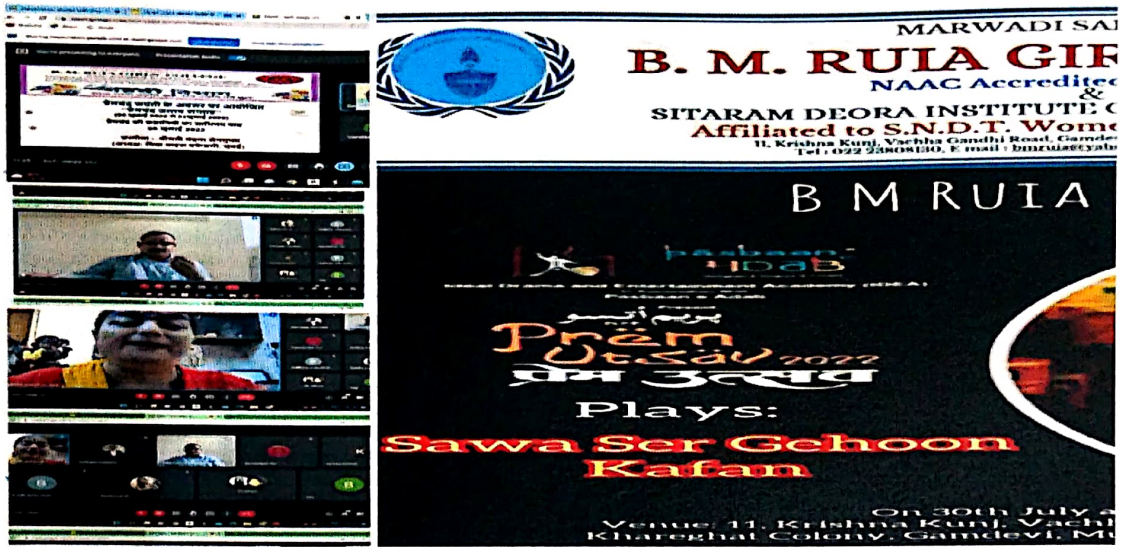
"B.M. Ruia Girls' College successfully conducted a week-long celebration to commemorate the birth anniversary of Premchand.

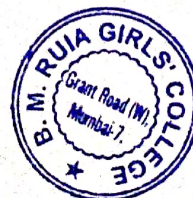

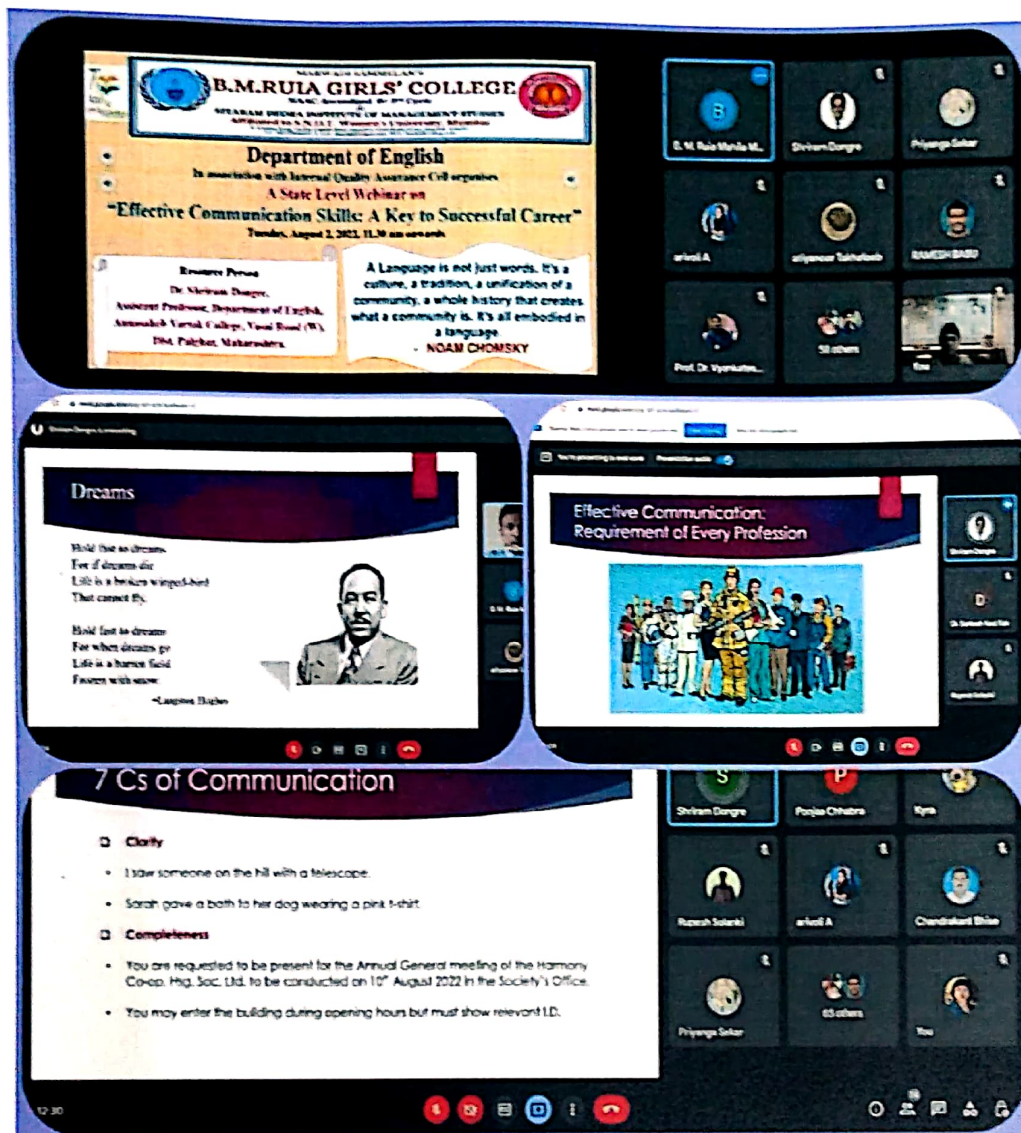
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communication in making a career, the concept of communication, 7 Cs of communication, methods of Communication and, and how to enhance English language skills for better communication.


21st September, 2022 – ‘Investment Avenues and Career Opportunities in Securities Market’.

A total of 121 students and 17 faculty members participated in this informative and engaging workshop.

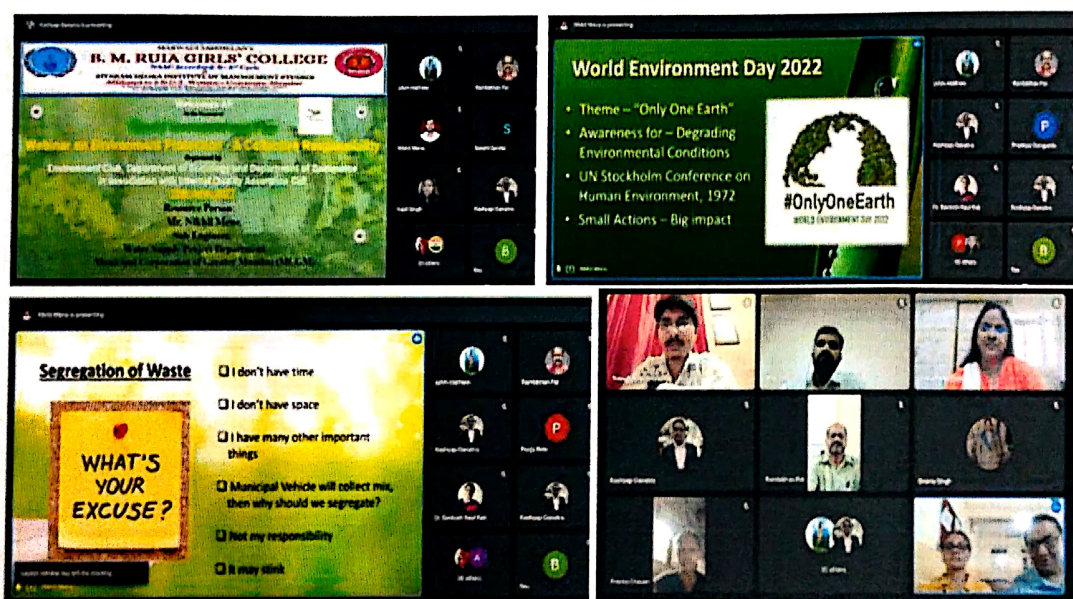
