Report on Kavita-Path and Group Discussion on the Occasion of Nagarjun Jayanti on 30th June, 2023 organised by the Department of Hindi.

C. Reports with Snaps: -

Report on Workshop on 'Patkatha Lekhan Evam Premchand: National Education Policy Evam Kaushalya Vikas'


The Department of Hindi organized an insightful workshop titled 'Patkatha Lekhan Evam Premchand: National Education Policy Evam Kaushalya Vikas'. The workshop focused on two main aspects: the art of Patkatha Lekhan (writing short stories), with a special emphasis on the works of the legendary writer Munshi Premchand, and how these connect to the National Education Policy (NEP) and Skill Development (Kaushalya Vikas). The workshop provided a comprehensive understanding of how literary writing can align with the goals of the NEP and contribute to the development of practical skills among students.

The Objective of the Workshop were:

- To provide participants with an understanding of the art of writing short stories (Patkatha Lekhan).
- To explore Munshi Premchand's storytelling techniques and their relevance in modern literature.
- To connect Premchand's work to the National Education Policy and discuss how it can promote

skills development (Kaushalya Vikas).



  
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- To discuss the importance of creative writing as a skill and its role in shaping well-rounded individuals as per the guidelines of the NEP.

The details of the workshop were :

#### 1. Introduction to Patkatha Lekhan:

- The session began with an introduction to the concept of Patkatha Lekhan (short story writing), where the participants learned about its key components, including plot development, character building, and themes.
- The importance of brevity, structure, and emotional depth in short stories was discussed in detail, highlighting how these elements can captivate readers in a limited word count.

#### 2. Munshi Premchand's Contribution to Patkatha Lekhan:

- A special segment was dedicated to Munshi Premchand's influence on Hindi and Urdu short stories.
- The facilitator provided a detailed analysis of some of Premchand's most famous short stories, such as "Kafan", "Panch Parmeshwar", and "Bade Bhai Sahab", explaining how these stories reflect societal issues, human emotions, and social reform.
- Participants discussed how Premchand's works can be used as a model to understand the nuances of storytelling, particularly in creating socially relevant narratives.

#### 3. The National Education Policy (NEP) and its Relevance to Literary Writing:

- A session was held on the National Education Policy (NEP) and how it aims to encourage creative writing, critical thinking, and skill-based education in Indian schools and colleges.
- The discussion focused on how the NEP emphasizes multidisciplinary learning, encouraging students to engage with literature and writing as part of a broader educational framework.
- The participants were encouraged to align the development of writing skills with NEP goals, fostering creative expression while addressing contemporary societal challenges.

#### 4. Kaushalya Vikas (Skill Development) through Literary Writing:

- The workshop explored the concept of Kaushalya Vikas (Skill Development), focusing on how writing short stories, analyzing literature, and engaging in creative writing activities can be powerful tools for skills development.
- Participants learned about the critical thinking and communication skills that are honed through writing and how these skills can contribute to personal and professional growth.
- The facilitator highlighted the importance of practical skills in today's educational context, noting how writing can enhance students' problem-solving abilities, empathy, and cultural awareness.

#### 5. Interactive Writing Session:

- The workshop included an interactive session where participants were asked to write a short story based on a given theme. This allowed attendees to apply the principles of short story writing discussed earlier and experiment with their creativity.

- After writing, participants shared their stories with the group and received constructive feedback from peers and the facilitator.

Approximately 62 participants, including scholars, professors, and students from various universities and colleges, associated with literature and cinema, took part in this workshop.

Online National Lecture on 'Indian Knowledge Tradition and Character Building' Concluded

30th September 2023 (Mumbai): As part of the Indian Knowledge Tradition Lecture Series, an online lecture on the topic '*Indian Knowledge Tradition and Character Building*' was organized by the Hindi Department of B.M. Ruia Girls College, managed by Marwadi Sammelan, in association with IQAC. The lecture was delivered by Dr. Rajneesh Kumar Shukla (Former Vice Chancellor, Mahatma Gandhi International Hindi University, Wardha) on 30th September 2023.

Dr. Rajneesh Kumar Shukla's lecture was divided into three parts. In the initial part, he clarified the difference between knowledge (Vidya) and wisdom (Jñāna), emphasizing the importance of knowledge and discussing the Indian knowledge tradition. He explained that the Indian knowledge tradition is capable of alleviating all forms of suffering—physical, divine, and worldly—and can liberate one from the bondage of these three. He further mentioned that what is now known as *Astrophysics* (the study of the universe) was once a part of this tradition.

In the second part of his lecture, Dr. Shukla emphasized that the Indian knowledge tradition focuses on the development of character that can contribute to individual, societal, national, and global progress. He stressed the importance of knowledge in shaping character, and how this tradition encourages the holistic development of individuals, not just in terms of education but also in terms of moral and spiritual growth.

In the final part of his lecture, Dr. Shukla discussed the significance of both *Para* (higher) and *Apara* (lower) knowledge systems, and their crucial roles in character building within the context of Indian knowledge tradition.

The lecture was attended by 52 education professionals from various cities across the country. The event was conducted and the vote of thanks was delivered by Mr. Ram Lakhan Pal, Assistant Professor of the Hindi Department.

This online national lecture successfully provided valuable insights into the deep connection between Indian knowledge traditions and the development of a strong moral character.

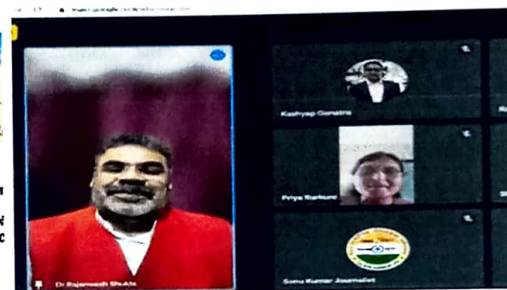
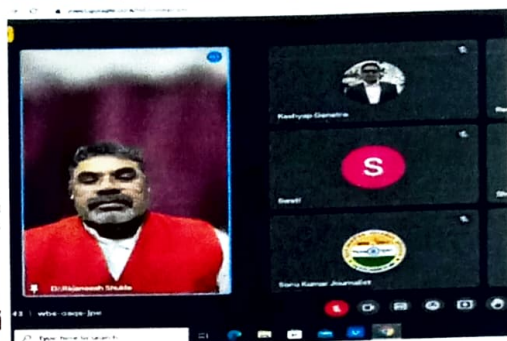

Students of B.M. Ruia Girl's College participated in a Seminar on 'Gandhi's Legacy: Sarvodaya and Religious Harmony'


On 4th October 2023, the third-year students of the Hindi Department of B.M. Ruia Girls College, Mumbai, participated in a seminar organized by the Mumbai Sarvodaya Mandal at the Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan on the topic '*Gandhi's Legacy: Sarvodaya and Religious Harmony*'.

The resource person for the seminar was Dr. Hubnath Pandey, professor from the Hindi Department at Mumbai University and a Gandhian thinker. Following his lecture, a discussion session took place, where the students of the college actively participated.

Dr. Pandey, in his lecture, explained the concept of heritage, discussing the historical roots of *Sarvodaya and Religious Harmony* from Emperor Ashoka and Gautam Buddha to the traditions of Emperor Akbar and the saints of the medieval period. 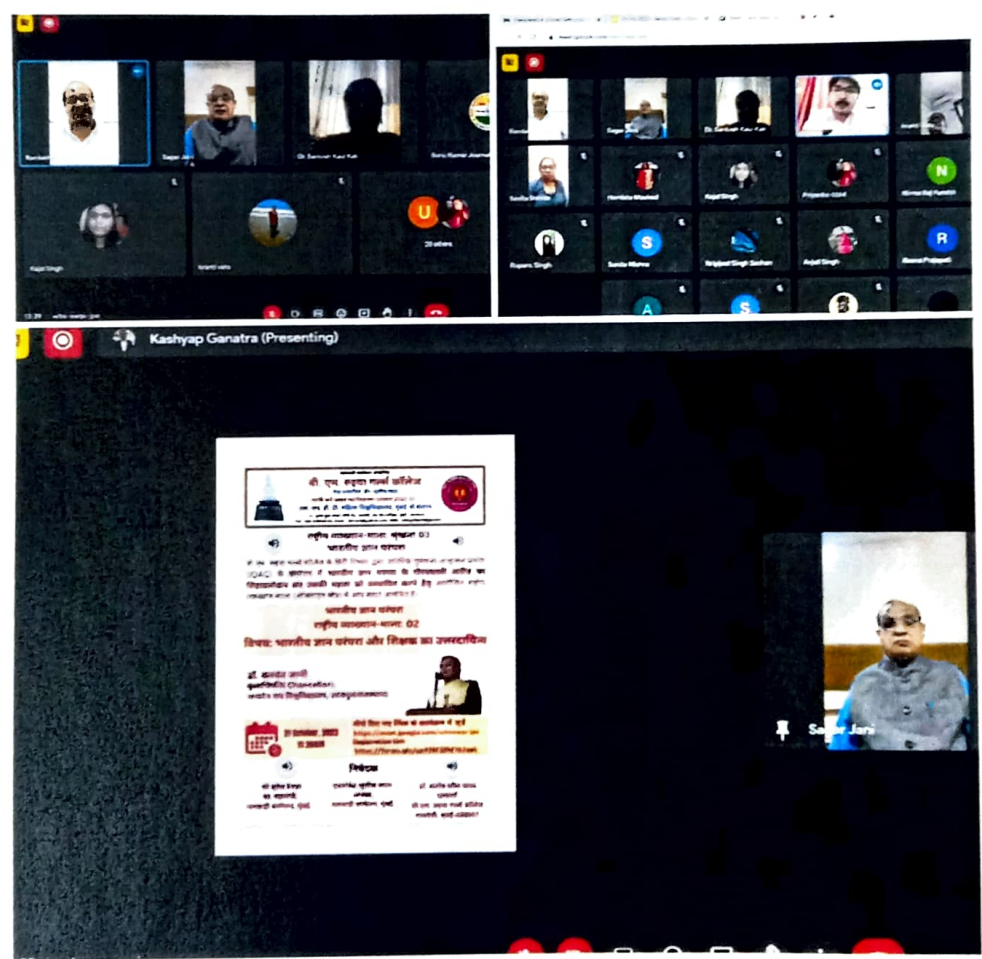

Reports with Snaps: On October 18, 2024, an online national lecture on the topic "Indian Knowledge Tradition and the Responsibility of Teachers" was successfully held under the guidance of Dr. Santosh Kaul Kak, Principal of B.M. Ruia Girls College, Gamdevi, Mumbai. The lecture was organized by the college's Hindi department in collaboration with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), after the college was honored with the 'Maharshi Karve Excellence College Award: 2022-23' by the Marwari Sammelan.

The eminent educationist, writer, and thinker Dr. Balwant Jani, who is also the Chancellor of Janardan Rai Nagar University, Udaipur, delivered the online national lecture. He began his talk by linking the relevance of the Indian knowledge tradition with the new National Education Policy (NEP). Dr. Jani highlighted that the NEP 2020 has given central importance to Indian knowledge traditions and emphasized that significant academic institutions around the world are continuously studying these traditions.

Discussing the responsibility of teachers, Dr. Jani compared Indian classical music with Western music. He noted that while Western music stimulates the brain, Indian classical music calms and energizes it. Further, he explained how a teacher shapes students by imparting qualities like humility, tolerance, discipline, and controlling their aggressive tendencies.

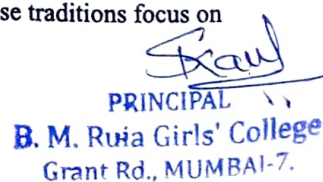

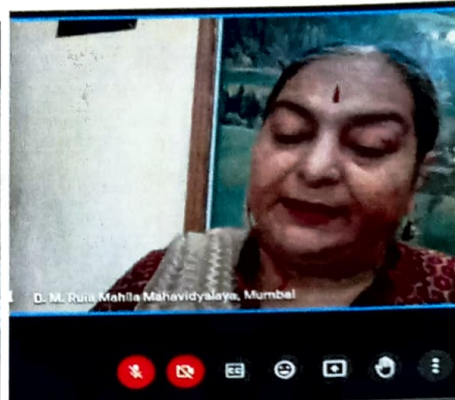

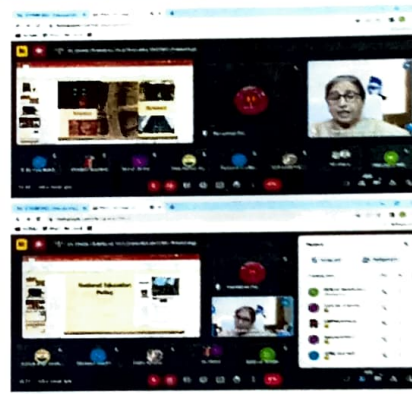

Online National Lecture on "Bhartiya Gyan Parampara aur Atmanirbharta" Concluded

On 23rd January 2024, the Hindi Department of B.M. Ruia Girls College, in collaboration with the IQAC, organized an online national lecture under the Indian Knowledge Tradition Lecture Series (Series 3). The lecture was delivered by Shri Bhujang Ramrao Bobde, Director of Knowledge Resource Centre, Research for Resurgence Foundation (Indian Teaching Council), Nagpur, Maharashtra, on the topic "*Bhartiya Gyan Parampara aur Atmanirbharta*".

In his lecture, Shri Bhujang Ramrao Bobde began with the famous Sanskrit shloka "सा विद्या या विमुक्तये", emphasizing the importance and relevance of karma (action) and vidya (knowledge). He pointed out the essential needs for self-reliance, such as clean air, clean water, and healthy food, emphasizing that these are fundamental requirements for a thriving and self-sustaining society.

The online national lecture was attended by 54 education professionals from various cities across the country. The session was conducted and coordinated by Shri Ramlakhan Pal, Assistant Professor in the Hindi Department, who also delivered the vote of thanks.

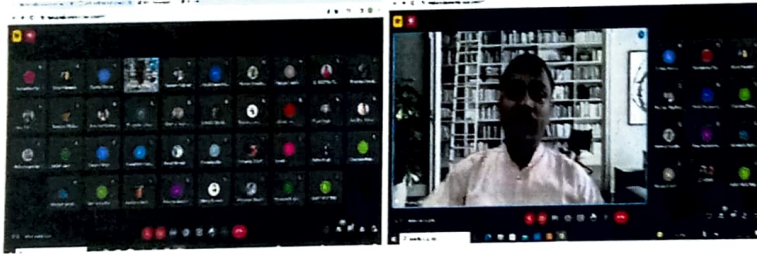

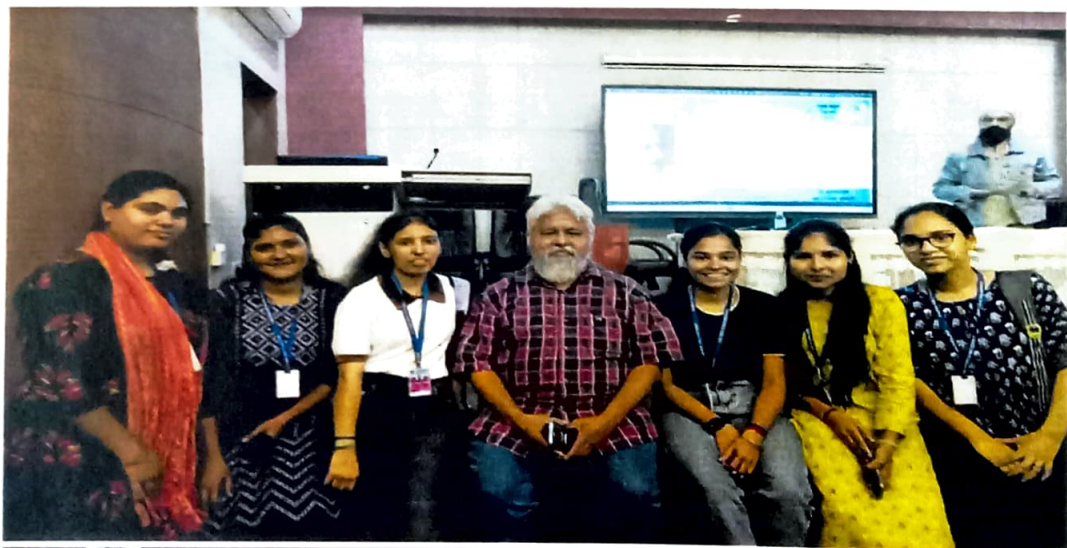



The session was moderated by Shri Ramlakhan Pal, Assistant Professor in the Hindi Department, who also delivered the vote of thanks.

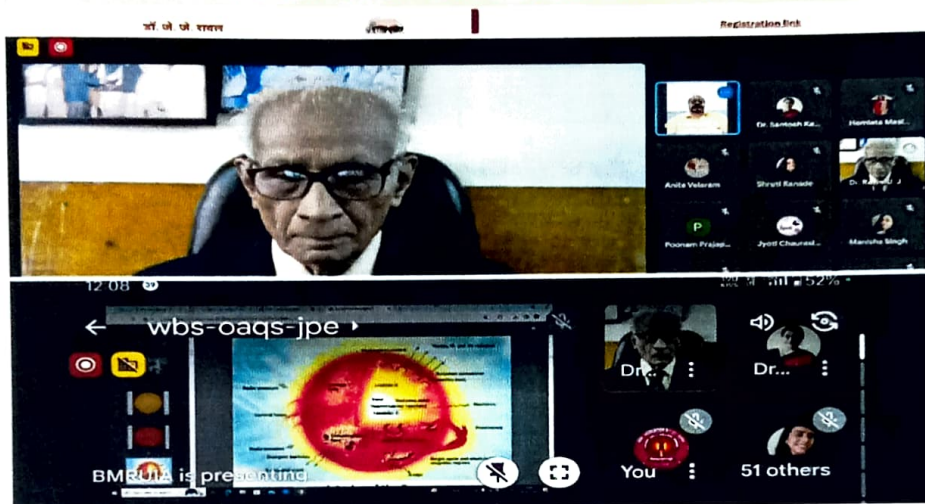

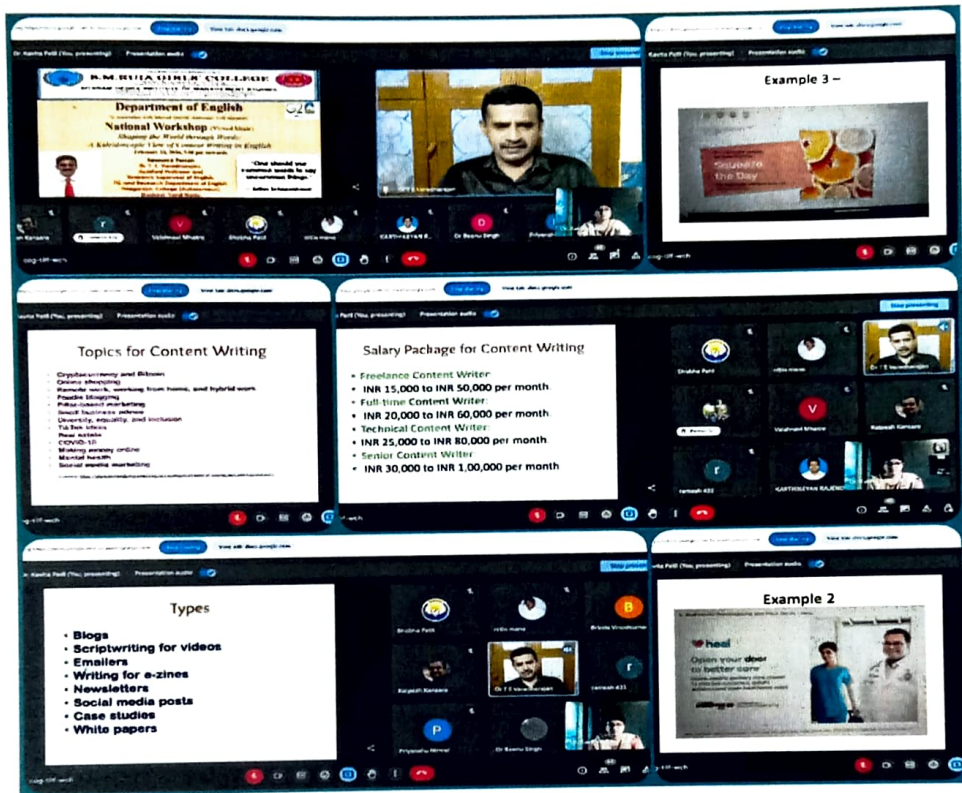

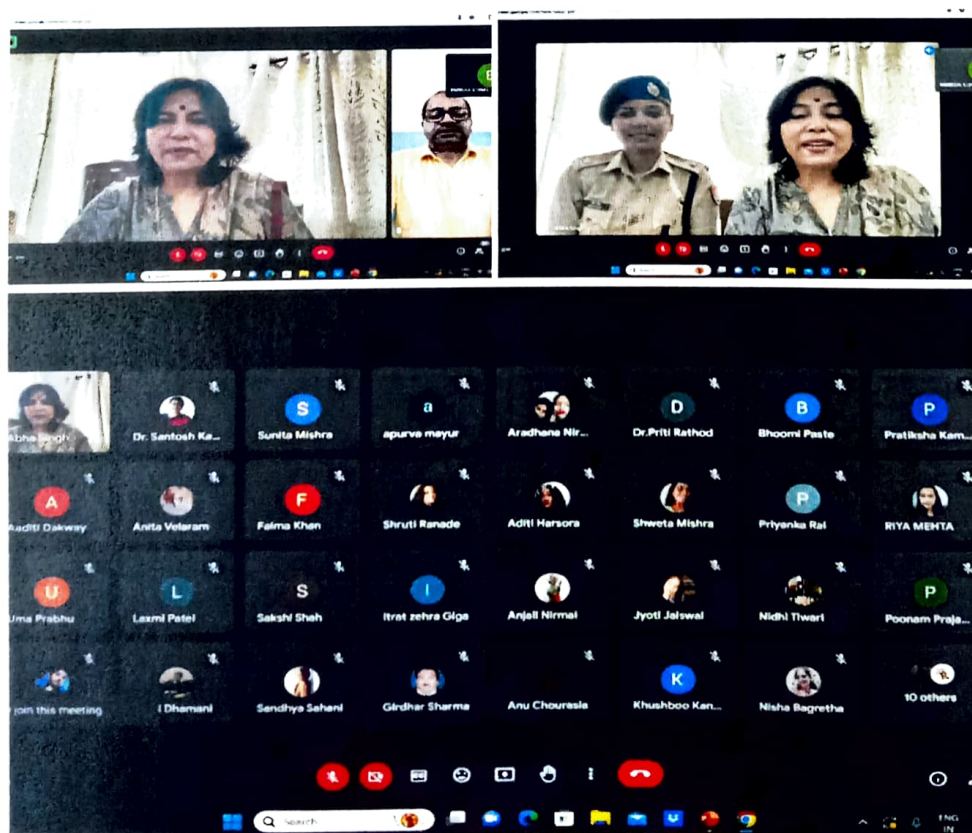

Online National Lecture on "Contribution of Women Scholars in Indian Knowledge Tradition" Concluded

*19 April 2024 (Mumbai):* Under the "Indian Knowledge Tradition Lecture Series," the Marwari Conference, in collaboration with the Hindi Department of B. M. Ruiya Girls College (awarded the Maharshi Karve Excellence College Award-2022-23) and in coordination with the IQAC (Internal Quality Assurance Cell), organized an online national lecture on the topic "Contribution of Women Scholars in Indian Knowledge Tradition" on 19 April 2024. The lecture was delivered by Dr. Acharya Radhavallabh Tripathi (Former Vice- Chancellor, Mahatma Gandhi International Hindi University, Wardha) on the topic "Indian Knowledge Tradition and Character Building."

Dr. Tripathi spoke about the warrior woman Vishpala from the Vedic era, highlighting the earliest reference to prosthetic limb implantation in the Indian knowledge tradition. He also mentioned the contributions of Brahmajnaani Apala and Gosha. He discussed the philosophical and metaphysical knowledge contributions of the Upanishadic Brahmajnaani scholar Rishi Gargi.


He elaborated on the importance of immortality and the Supreme Reality as emphasized by the scholar Rishi Maitreyee in Indian knowledge tradition. Additionally, Dr. Tripathi highlighted the contributions of Sulabha and Suvarchala from the Upanishadic and Mahabharata periods, noting their significant contributions to philosophical knowledge in the Indian tradition. He also discussed the interrelationship between words and language.

Dr. Tripathi further elaborated on the contributions of the great 12th-century scholar Leelavati to the field of mathematics within the Indian knowledge tradition, as well as Avantisundari's contributions to poetics. The lecture concluded with a discussion on the importance of words and meaning in poetry.



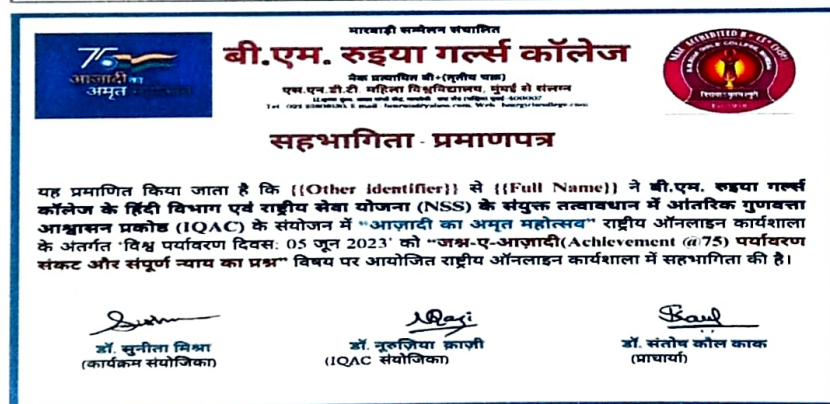

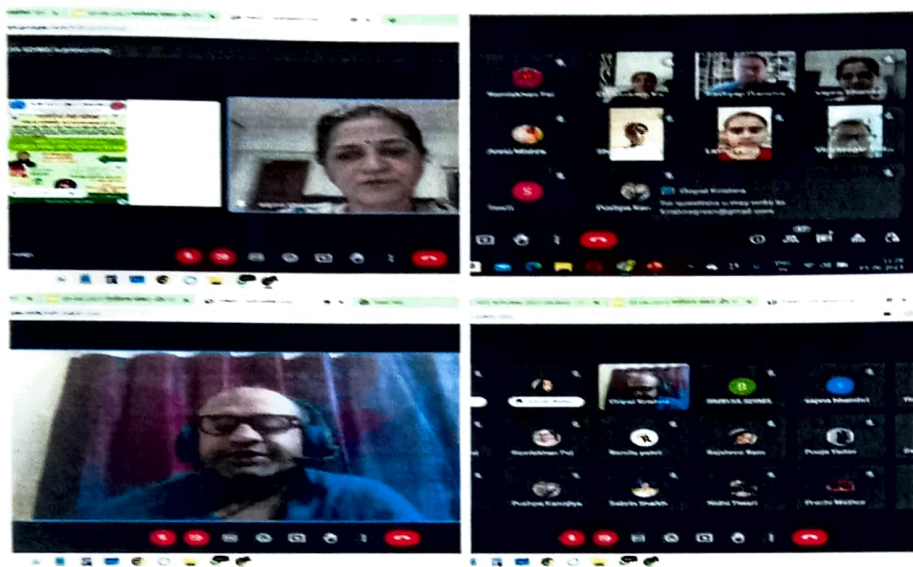
Academic Year: 2023-2024 Activities Organized by the Hindi Department National Online Workshop on "Environmental Crisis and the Question of Comprehensive Justice" Concluded on World Environment Day under 'Jashn-E-Azadi: Achievement @75' 5 June 2023 (Mumbai): On the occasion of World Environment Day, a national online workshop on the topic "Environmental Crisis and the Question of Comprehensive Justice" was held at B. M. Ruia Girls College under Jashn-E-Azadi Amrit Mahotsav' (Achievement @75). The workshop was organized by the Hindi Department and IQAC, in collaboration with Dr. Gopal Krishna (Renowned Environmentalist, New Delhi) as the keynote speaker.

Dr. Gopal Krishna began his address by quoting the conversation between Bhishma and Yudhishtir in the Shanti Parva of the Mahabharata, where Yudhishtir asks Bhishma about the nature of Earth, mountains, seas, rivers, the sun, moon, air, fire, sky, and horizon. In response, Bhishma offers a detailed explanation of the environment, stating that nature, or the environment, is a manifestation of God. This conversation is

similarly reflected in the dialogues between Maharishi Bhrigu and Rishi Bharadwaj in the Vedas.

Dr. Krishna clarified the environmental crisis through the concepts of epistemology and metaphysics, explaining the six elements: perception, inference, analogy, postulation, non-apprehension, and verbal testimony. During the workshop, he emphasized that addressing the current environmental crisis requires the participation of not only the Indian government and institutions but also every individual. He stressed the importance of establishing environmental departments in every institution and organization, highlighting that every tree and plant is our sibling and we must live with this awareness. The workshop was attended by 50 environmental enthusiasts and respected members of the education sector via Google Meet in online mode.
