

The Department of Commerce, in association with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell, organized the Investor Awareness Programme - Session on Mutual Funds' on 11th October, 2023, as part of an initiative by the Securities Exchange Board of India (SEBI), in collaboration with Franklin Templeton, Asset Management Company.

The Resource Person for the session was Ms. Neha Goyani, Sales Manager, Franklin Templeton. The thrust of the Investor Awareness Programme was "A smart investor does not act on unsolicited investment offers."




