

This awareness workshop focused on increasing knowledge and awareness of Cyber Safety in digital spaces, focusing on Women and Child Safety Online to enhance security knowledge on the cyber domain. Advocate Noelle Ann Park explained to the students' various topics like Cyberbullying, Cyber Stalking, Impersonation online, Child pornography, Cyber threats through online chat rooms and online video games, Exposure to illegal and problematic content, Extortion online, Solicitation online, etc.

The sessions were very interactive through student polls and case studies. Information on various laws enacted for the protection and safety of women and children were shared, which was very useful to the students. Understanding the relevant legislations and how they can receive justice about various crimes under different laws was also explained very well to students. Overall, the Workshop was very informative and proved to be a needed session for the students, mainly as many use online education modes during this Pandemic period

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


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"5 DAYS ONLINE TRAINING PROGRAMME ON DISASTER PREPAREDNESS"

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
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WORKSHOP ON OVERVIEW OF FINANCIAL MARKETS

She explained that the current NEP had replaced the 34-year-old national education policy

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
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formulated in 1986. She briefed on the five pillars of NEP: Access, Equity, Quality, Affordability, and Accountability.


The lecture was also aired via Google Meet and was well received and attended by Participants, Students, and Faculties.

A total of 33 teams from 09 colleges and 10 departments participated. Following were the colleges that participated in the competition.



The seminar commenced with the ceremonial lighting of the lamp and Saraswati Vandana followed by Maharashtra Geet and SNDT Women's University Song संस्कृता स्त्री पराशक्ती, during the Inaugural Session.

The Principals of both the institutes, Dr. Deepa Sharma and Dr. Santosh Kaul Kak, welcomed and felicitated the dignitaries on the dais.

Dr. Deepa Sharma, Principal, Shri M. D. Shah Mahila College of Arts and Commerce, extended a warm welcome to the esteemed dignitaries and participants. She provided a comprehensive overview of the seminar's significance and objectives, highlighting the collaborative synergy

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between the colleges. She elaborated on the evolving role of IQAC within the dynamic educational scenario, emphasizing its potential in planning and seamlessly integrating technology to enhance educational practices.

While delivering his address, Dr. Mohanbhai Patel, President of Janseva Samiti, imparted blessings to the audience and placed emphasis on transforming mindsets and attitudes towards teaching and learning. He illustrated this point through various examples and Shlokas, highlighting the importance of embracing change and adopting a positive approach to education.

Advocate Shri Sushil Vyas, President of Marwadi Sammelan, expressed gratitude to both the Honourable Vice Chancellors for their presence at the Seminar and recognized their significant contributions in planning, promoting awareness, and implementing the National Education Policy. He also extended his best wishes for the seminar, and appreciated the teams of both the colleges for their collaborative efforts.

Dr. Rajan Welukar, in his Keynote address enlightened the participants on the topic "Quality and Technology in Higher Education Changing Context". He mentioned the struggle and efforts of Bharat Ratna Maharshi Dr. Dhondo Keshav Karve and Savitribai Phule for paving the way for women education. He emphasized on using relevant technology for enhancing the quality of higher education institutions. He spoke about the concept of speed and velocity and recommended that if we need to have pace with today's world, we need to be adaptive and understand the rate of change, as quality is a process and learning is lifelong. Sir guided about dimensions for maintaining quality in education, focus on student centric approach, creation of E-portfolios for every student, empowerment through reflection, critical thinking, encouragement of diversity, connectivity, inclusion, importance of interdisciplinary and multi-disciplinary programs, etc. and how autonomy can help in achieving the institutional goals.

Honourable Vice Chancellor Madam of SNDT Women's University, Prof. Ujwala Chakradeo, reflected on Swami Vivekananda's teachings regarding education during her Presidential address. She emphasized the importance of making learning enjoyable for students, highlighting that our inner world holds greater significance than external world. Prof. Ujwala Chakradeo noted that despite our inherent spirituality, modern discussions often prioritize materialistic gains. She expressed optimism about the National Education Policy shifting towards a more informal paradigm, encouraging deeper introspection and a connection with our cultural heritage. Madam emphasized the importance of internalization of values while adapting to the era of constant change.

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Honourable VC Madam informed about the innovative Project Jagrani, a research initiative undertaken by the university on Rishikas. She mentioned that till date, the research had revealed significant contributions of about 35 Rishikas to the Vedic scriptures. Through short videos created by the university, students were trained to narrate the teachings of these remarkable women, emphasizing the importance of narrating their stories from Vedic literature. This initiative, aims to honour and promote the invaluable contributions of these women to our cultural and intellectual heritage. Honourable VC Madam informed about an innovative 30-hour program, which includes a 3-day residential training, designed to empower students to earn 2 credits. They will be called as 'Narayani'. This role involves engaging with the community to raise awareness and share knowledge about the remarkable achievements of these Rishikas.

Honourable VC Madam expressed the importance of empowering women and how knowledge, when embraced as a संस्कृता (Sanskrita), can lead to the transformation of the world. She stressed that IQAC's role is to provide an environment of mutual respect and freedom, ensuring that students derive joy from their learning. Madam mentioned the significance of holistic learning, willingness of teachers to become co-learners and encouraging colleges and universities to undertake multidisciplinary projects. Hon'ble VC Madam also encouraged the colleges to pursue autonomy.

Both Vice Chancellors appreciated the collaborative efforts of Shri M. D. Shah Mahila College of Arts and Commerce and B. M. Ruia Girls' College for organizing the seminar, mentioning that such collaborations align with the principles outlined in the National Education Policy.

Dr. Santosh Kaul Kak, Principal, B. M. Ruia Girls' College, proposed the vote of thanks to all the dignitaries, management of both the institutes, IQAC Team, participants from other colleges for their gracious presence. She also reassured that both colleges would continue to empower students through ongoing collaborative activities

In Plenary Session I, Dr. B. S. Madhukar, Ex-Executive Committee member of NAAC, enlightened on the theme "The Changing Role of IQAC". He emphasized the need for IQAC to revisit concepts such as best practices and highlighted the significance of identifying internal communication barriers, which can incur costs in terms of time. Effective time management is crucial for the efficient functioning of colleges. He stressed that institutions must prioritize the interests of their stakeholders and promote collaborative efforts to achieve common goals. Dr. Madhukar advocated for institutions to assess their talent pool dynamics and provide appropriate training, while also addressing issues of equality, inclusion, and diversity by ensuring equal rights for all individuals.

He suggested planning activities in a manner that maximizes effectiveness and offered tips for implementing best practices. Dr. Madhukar emphasized that the role of IQAC is expanding, with the integration of AI becoming essential, and stressed the importance of selecting suitable technology for institutional needs. He discussed the significance of developing intellectual growth and advancing knowledge in higher education, referencing the journey from a teacher (Adhyapak) to a mentor (Guru) and highlighting teaching as an internal exploration.

During Plenary Session II, the topic, "AI for Institutional Data Management" was presented. Mr. Bhushan Ambedkar and his team from Divine Campus Infotech Private Limited presented their software specially designed to address various challenges related to admission, data input, examination management, admission processes, internal evaluations, certificate management, and other administrative and evaluative tasks essential for colleges. During the presentation, they highlighted the benefits of their software, which includes an AI personal tutor available 24/7 for both, teachers and students, a system for generating and evaluating papers, and other functionalities. They emphasized that while there is a common misconception that AI replaces teachers, their software is designed to assist teachers rather than replace them

During the Valedictory Session, Dr. Pramod Pabrekar, Senior Consultant at PM USHA, delivered a talk focusing on the theme "Leveraging Alumni Network and Support." He emphasized the continuous need for teachers to prioritize learning, which in turn enhances their approach to delivering lectures and ensures quality in the teaching-learning process. He stressed the importance of regularly visiting websites such as NAAC, UGC, AICTE, and government portals to stay updated on changes related to the implementation of the National Education Policy. He encouraged the audience to maintain strong relationships with alumni through modern Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) solutions. This approach ensures that alumni remain active stakeholders in the ongoing educational reforms. Dr. Pabrekar also shared insights into his own role as an alumnus and highlighted his continued contribution even after retirement. In conclusion, Dr. Pabrekar reiterated the significance of lifelong learning and staying informed about educational advancements as key factors for successful teaching and institutional development.

The event was meticulously planned and executed by IQAC Teams of both the institutes and gracefully anchored by Dr. Subha Acharya, Dr. Ceena Paul, Dr. Nooruzia Qazi, Dr. Anita Jacob, and Dr. Sumita Guha, faculty members from both the colleges.

The National Level Seminar successfully facilitated knowledge exchange, networking, and collaboration among participants. It witnessed insightful deliberations, discussions, and the exchange of innovative ideas driven by technology. The seminar concluded successfully, receiving positive feedback from the participants.
