WASTE MANAGEMENT PRACTICES AT B. M. RUIA GIRLS' COLLEGE

SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT:

- The college segregates canteen kitchen waste into wet and dry categories, ensuring effective collection and disposal by municipal garbage trucks.
- Non-degradable waste, such as newspapers, plastics, and other recyclables, is sold to scrap dealers to facilitate recycling.
- The NSS unit creatively recycles old newspapers into paper bags, which are distributed to local stores and vendors, promoting eco-conscious practices.
- Old, unused folders are upcycled using fabric, demonstrating innovative approaches to reusability.
- A “best out of waste” initiative encourages students and staff to repurpose materials and reduce overall waste.
- Awareness programs and workshops on waste management are organized regularly, instilling a “reduce, reuse, and recycle” mindset within the college community.
- The college monitors waste generation on campus to identify areas for further improvement and reduce environmental impact.

LIQUID WASTE MANAGEMENT:

- Sewage and kitchen liquid waste are processed through properly maintained underground sewage systems, preventing contamination and promoting hygienic disposal.

E-WASTE MANAGEMENT:

- The college adheres to a structured process for e-waste management, including identifying, segregating, and disposing of damaged or obsolete electronics through certified vendors.
- Annual Maintenance Contracts (AMCs) for IT equipment ensure prolonged hardware life and minimize e-waste generation.
- An e-waste disposal drive collected 126 kg of discarded electronics, handed over to The Recycling Company (THRECO) for safe and eco-friendly recycling, receiving recognition for these efforts.
- Students and staff are educated about responsible e-waste disposal through campaigns, encouraging them to bring their e-waste for proper disposal on campus.
- E-Waste bins are placed strategically on the premises, making it easy for students and staff to deposit electronic waste responsibly.
