Panchayat located in Palghar (district) on 30th September, 2023 and cleaned the road from Gram Panchayat Office, Umroli to Umroli Library.

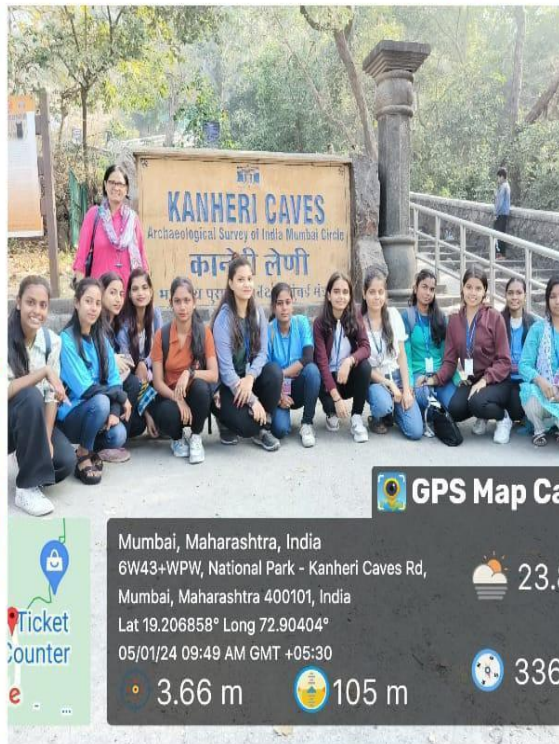
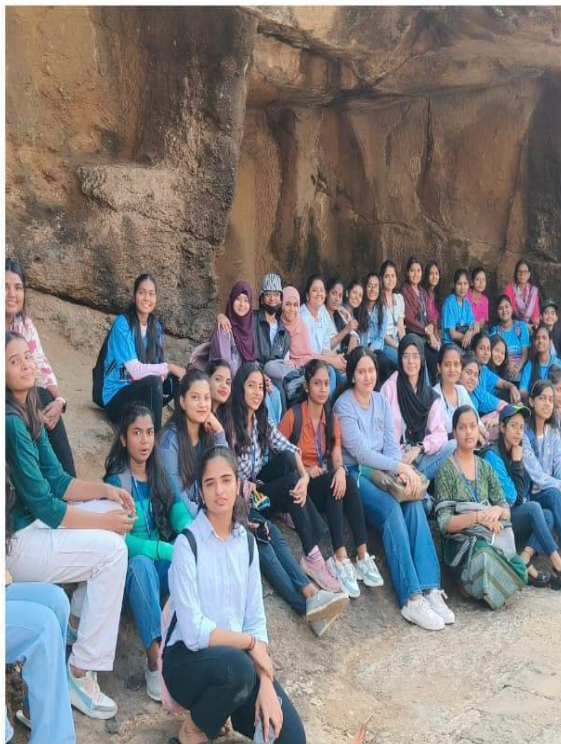
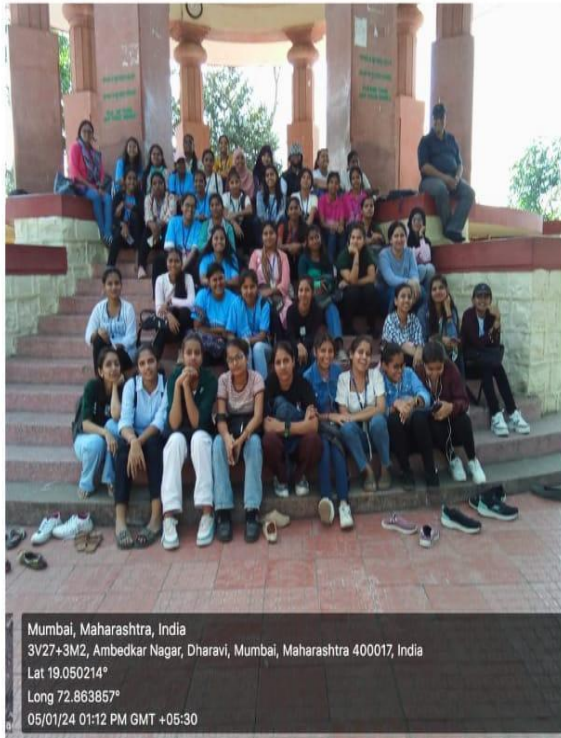

Concerned local authorities in the municipality shall be alerted and will be able to take action. Most students have downloaded the app during this presentation and few have expressed they would use it when required. Students agreed to use this app regularly, and they would spread the knowledge about this app in community. Students were informed that while using the app they have to be careful and formal and must properly logout and quit after each time they use the app. Students were informed about the mobile app safety behaviour to be adopted while using any app which tracks location and is allowed to click photos.
