members are encouraged to participate in the Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Programme (MM-TTP), for the Orientation and Sensitization of the Faculty members on core NEP 2020 themes. Faculty members were requested to enrol for the training programme through online mode to complete the Training. Some Teachers have registered and participated in NEP 2020 Faculty Development Programmes conducted by HRDC and MMTTC.

The Government Skill Development Courses are conducted at B.M. Ruia Girls' College under MOU with Saraswati Seva Pratishthan. During the academic year 2022-23, Three Courses were conducted under Government of Maharashtra, Skill Employment, Entrepreneurship and Innovation Department, Maharashtra State Board of Skill, Vocational Education and Training, viz. Customer Relationship Management (CRM) Domestic Voice, Data Entry Operator, Street Food Vendor. The Exam for Street Food Vendor was conducted on 10th October, 2023 and Customer Relationship Management (CRM) Domestic Voice, Data Entry Operator was held on 18th October, 2023. The Certificates were distributed on 12th January, 2024.

These include having at least two faculty members recognised as Ph.D. Guides in the relevant subject and the availability of a Postgraduate programme in the subject for which recognition is sought.

Feedback was collected from students, alumni, faculty, and employers through structured forms and online surveys. The IQAC reviewed and analyzed the responses to identify key areas for improvement. Based on the suggestions received, measures such as enhancing ICT usage in teaching, organizing soft skills and career guidance sessions, job fairs, and strengthening alumni engagement were proposed and conducted.

Few staff members visited the schools and junior colleges under School Connect Programme to orient staff and students on the new NEP 2020 structure and to raise awareness about SNDT Women's University, and the courses offered by the University and our college. The presentation was shared with all the Staff members, which should be used for orienting and creating awareness on implementation of NEP 2020. It is proposed to plan and visit schools
